ABOUT THE PHYSIOLOGY AND NEUROBIOLOGY REU

- NSF-funded **Research Experience for Undergraduates (REU)** offering undergraduates a paid summer research internship.
- Participants spend **10 weeks** with UConn faculty and graduate students working on graduate-level research projects.
- Weekly professional development workshops covering grad school applications, interviewing, ethics, and more.

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a U.S. citizen, U.S. national, or U.S. permanent resident
- Must be available for the entire 10 weeks
- Must be enrolled at an undergraduate institution: expected graduation no sooner than Sep 2024

To provide students, especially those from non-PhD granting institutions, an opportunity to do intensive research and advance their scientific careers. Minorities, veterans, first-generation college students, and students with disabilities are encouraged to apply.
